The above assumes that the notebooks are not college ruled. Spiral notebooks only please- no composition books. Also, anything bigger than 10 1/2” x 8” will not fit in the desks. 5 folders- (plastic last longer)- 1 red, 1 blue, 1 green, 1 black, 1 picture or pattern of your choice, 3 rolls scotch tape (keep 2 home), 10 pencils- #2 only(replenish as needed), 4 glue sticks (keep 2 home), 1- 3”x 3” Post-it notes, crayons or markers, scissors, pens- blue, black and red, package of loose leaf paper, hand-held pencil sharpener, water bottle with closable top, eraser , *soft pencil box- at least an inch deep , textbook covers. Math 8

3 ring binder (2 inch) with at least 4 dividers, TI30 X IIS calculator, 1 two pocket folder, 1 package of graph paper (1/4 inch), 1 package of loose leaf paper, 1 large package of #2 pencils

Advanced Math grade 8:

1 spiral notebook – 3 Subject, 1 pkg. graph paper (1/4 inch), 1 pocket folder, 1 package of pencils, 1 package of pens (blue or black)
